

Download eBooks to a Kindle

You will need a valid library card, personal computer (Windows, Mac or Linux) with Internet access, and Amazon.com account.

1. Start with your personal computer...

- Set up an Amazon account at www.amazon.com.
- Goto www.shpl.info and click on blue “Downloads: eBooks & eAudio” button, or goto www.live-brary.com directly.
- Click on “eBooks” from the “Services” menu on the left sidebar.
- Click on “My Account” on the dark-blue horizontal toolbar and log in with your library barcode.

2. Find a book at Live-brary.com...

- On the search bar, toggle “All Formats” to “Kindle Book”.
- Enter a title or author in the search box, and check off “Only show titles with copies available” under the search box to limit results to what’s available now.
- Click the “Add to My Cart” link directly across to the right of the Kindle book icon.
- Click “Proceed to Checkout”.
- Click “Confirm Checkout”.
- Click “Get for Kindle”. A second window will now open.

3. Finish the transaction at Amazon.com... Enjoy!

- On “Get Your Public Library Loan Page”, click the yellow “Get Library Book” button on the right.
- Complete Amazon account form and click “Sign in Using Our Secure Server”.
- Choose Deliver to Kindle –OR– Computer.

Deliver to Kindle Wirelessly	Deliver to Computer
If you choose Deliver to Kindle, you must have access to a wireless network. Library books are delivered over Wi-Fi and not 3G or “WhisperNet”. Please turn off 3G on your Kindle at this time (if possible).	If you choose computer, and if you haven’t done so already, you will be prompted to download the Kindle app for PC/Apple/iPad etc. or use the Kindle Cloud Reader service. If your Kindle does not have wireless connectivity, you may dock your Kindle via USB and “drag and drop” the title onto it.

- Click “Continue”.
- Titles will appear on your Kindle (or app) the next time a “sync” occurs. This can be a few seconds or a few minutes. Please be patient.

NOTE: “Action button” within your Amazon account allows you to return book early, or change delivery options for titles.
