OUTREACH SERVICES

South Huntington Public Library aspires to make resources & materials available to all members of our community - including those unable to visit the building.

With that vision in mind, we offer home delivery services to residents of our district who are not able to travel to the library due to age, disability, illness, or a temporary issue with accessing the library.

Residents must sign up for a South Huntington library card if they do not already have one. We can assist with this process and there is no fee for this service.

HOW IT WORKS

Home Delivery

Patrons can sign up to receive materials delivered by our volunteers on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly basis. There is also an option to have deliveries on a “by request” basis. Librarians will choose items based on the patron’s preferences or the patron may request specific items to be delivered.
