Try Making a Butterfly Puddle!

Butterflies visit puddles for water, but also for salt and minerals. They like to gather around the damp edges of puddles instead of landing in the water. Sometimes, their favorite spots are where water has already evaporated from a puddle but the ground is still moist. They visit puddling sites during the heat of the day, typically between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. You can help attract butterflies by sprinkling a little sea salt in a small puddle. Now sit back and watch to see if any of these beautiful pollinators visit your butterfly puddle!
